 Upbringing, beliefs, sexual history, all feed into expectations and baggage we bring into marriage.

Why did God create sexual intimacy?

- Create a unique, personal, spiritual, physical bond between husband and wife.

II. Setting yourselves up for a lifetime of fun and fulfillment

Now, getting down to the questions you asked in your letter to me. First, Is it a good thing to have sexual relations?

Certainly—but only within a certain context. It's good for a man to have a wife, and for a woman to have a husband. Sexual drives are strong, but *marriage is strong enough to contain them* and provide for a balanced and fulfilling sexual life in a world of sexual disorder.

The marriage bed must be a place of **mutuality**—the husband seeking to satisfy his wife, the wife seeking to satisfy her husband.

Marriage is not a place to "stand up for your rights." Marriage is a decision to **serve the other**, whether in bed or out.

1 Corinthians 7: 1-6 (MSG)

To Men: What a wife wishes her husband knew about sex

Sexual Intimacy is about Relationship, not an Act

In her mind, sexual intimacy is tied to all relational components

Husbands need to know their wives

- 1 Peter 3, "Live with your wives in an understanding way"
- OT Terms

Listen & love, rather than shutdown & solve

Sexual intimacy is a process, not an isolated event

Communicate your intentions or desires

- Direct request
- Let go of ego and fear of rejection
- Spontaneous vs Scheduled

Be affectionate all the time! Speak her love language

manipulation

Microwave vs. crockpot

The atmosphere matters

Take initiative and responsibility to make your wife comfortable and the intimacy pleasurable.

Physical environment

Have a romantic get away

- Prioritize
- Tune up (at least 2x/year)

If your wife does not want to be intimate, it's not about you!

Why a woman may not desire sexual intimacy?

Sexual past

- Restoration
- Better with time and experience

She is not rejecting YOU

 Explore her concerns & needs, show her you are there for her (without any selfish motives) To Women: What a husband wishes his wife knew about sexual intimacy

Sexual intimacy is more important to him than you think

- It is the way he was designed!
- Intertwined with everything he feels and thinks- his identity, his ego, expression of love.
- He may be thinking of being with you all day, and you may not have had a thought at all!

Intimacy is tied to his identity

- Rejection = major blow to his ego and identity
 - On the positive side... "The whole world can be falling apart but if we have sex, it's okay!"
 - On the negative side...
- He does fantasize about you! Embrace it!
 - Negative reaction to compliment = sex = negative reflection of him

If you are not able to be intimate...

- Separate not wanting to be intimate that night with not wanting to be intimate with him
 - Express desire and offer alternative

Ultimate goal: COMMUNICATE love, value, worth

For many men... sexual temptation is a struggle in his life

- Temptation is not sin
- Bombarded constantly with visual stimulation
 - Battle: what to do with the thoughts that come to his mind
- Temptation greater when sexual emptiness is greater
 - Marriage: only legitimate sexual outlet he has

Temptation...

• Doesn't mean he's not attracted to you

•Doesn't mean he doesn't love God

Doesn't mean he's going to act on it.

Sex is the ultimate expression of love

- To her...love is...quality time and listening.
 - When he speaks her language, she feels loved and desires to connect sexually
- To him...love is...sexual intimacy
 - •When she speaks his language, he feels loved and desires to connect emotionally

*Many wives can feel genuinely loved and cherished by their husband without sexual intimacy.

The High and Low Frequency Cycles

- When men are empty sexually, it is difficult to be open emotionally.
- When women are empty emotionally, it is difficult to be open sexually.

- When men are fulfilled sexually, it is easier to be open emotionally.
- When women are fulfilled emotionally, it is easier to be open sexually.

Low Frequency Cycle
